Story Ship will also return to Douglasville on June 11<sup>th</sup> with their show, “Pirate Goodie and the Magic Chest” from 4-5pm at O’Neal Plaza. That performance is free and open to the public.

Both these shows are part of CAC’s “Family ArtVentures!” program that brings curricula-based performances into the schools, followed by a public performance for parents to enjoy with their children.
