**Artists and Teachers are Invited to Share their Skills and Knowledge**

*Douglasville, Georgia* – The Cultural Arts Council of Douglasville/ Douglas County wants to add to its program of arts classes. Teachers and artists interested in conducting a program should contact the CAC for a proposal form. CAC is currently recruiting teachers for the summer and fall sessions.

The teacher/artists are independent contractors who can propose a single event workshop, a short duration class or a multi-week class. They select their own date and time to conduct their class and the fee they want to charge. CAC takes 25% of the tuition for the marketing, registration and facility costs.

“We are looking for the gamut of options, such as painting, sculpture, jewelry-making, recycled art, music and vocal programs,” said Davina Grace Hill, Executive Director of the CAC. “We are also seeking programs in diverse areas such as fashion design, floral arrangements, Tai Chi movement, and possibly 3-D sculpture, using new 3-D pen technology.”
