EVENT DETAILS

DATE: Saturday, September 14, 2024, from 11 am - 4 pm at the Cultural Arts Center

You will be advised no later than August 14, 2024 if your group has been accepted into the Mosaic: Multicultural Festival.

PROCEEDS: All sales are your own. Your \$30 entry fee supports the work of the Cultural Arts Council.

ENTRY FEE & REQUIREMENTS: The entry fee for a vendor is \$30, to be submitted no later than July 17, 2024. Vendors assume responsibility for all materials brought to the event, and neither the Cultural Arts Council nor its representatives accept liability for damages to persons or property sustained as a result of Mosaic: Multicultural Festival.

BOOTHS: Booth spaces are 10'x10'. Your tent must be 10'x10' or smaller. Larger tents CANNOT be accommodated as space at the event is very tight. **Electrical outlets will not be available.**

CULTURAL REPRESENTATION: We are asking each vendor to provide educational information about a specific culture. This can include facts on a board, samples of a cultural food, demos, giveaway items, etc.

AWARD: The community will get to vote for the vendor with the best decorated cultural booth. The winner will be announced the following week after all votes have been tabulated.

ROAMING FEE

For \$10 per person, (with or without a booth), your business or organization can roam the entire event and hand out menus, business cards, coupons, or restaurant giveaways to help attract people to your booth or business. A special "roamer" button will designate authorized roamers. Anyone passing out materials without a roamer button will be asked to leave the event.

EVENT SET-UP: Vendors will receive their booth assignment and maps at least one week prior to the event. Set-up will begin on Saturday morning at 7:30 am, and vendors should be prepared for early visitors by 10:30 am. Parking is available near the event at Douglas County High School. Please bring rolling carts or other means of transporting your goods from your vehicle to your booth site, as access for vehicles to your booth location is very limited. We cannot guarantee that you will be able to drive up to your space that morning. After the event, vendors should be cleaned up by 5:30 pm. Trash pick-up will occur at 5:30 pm, and any materials remaining will be removed.

NOTE: This is a rain or shine event, with no scheduled rain date. Once accepted into the event, all fees paid are non-refundable.
